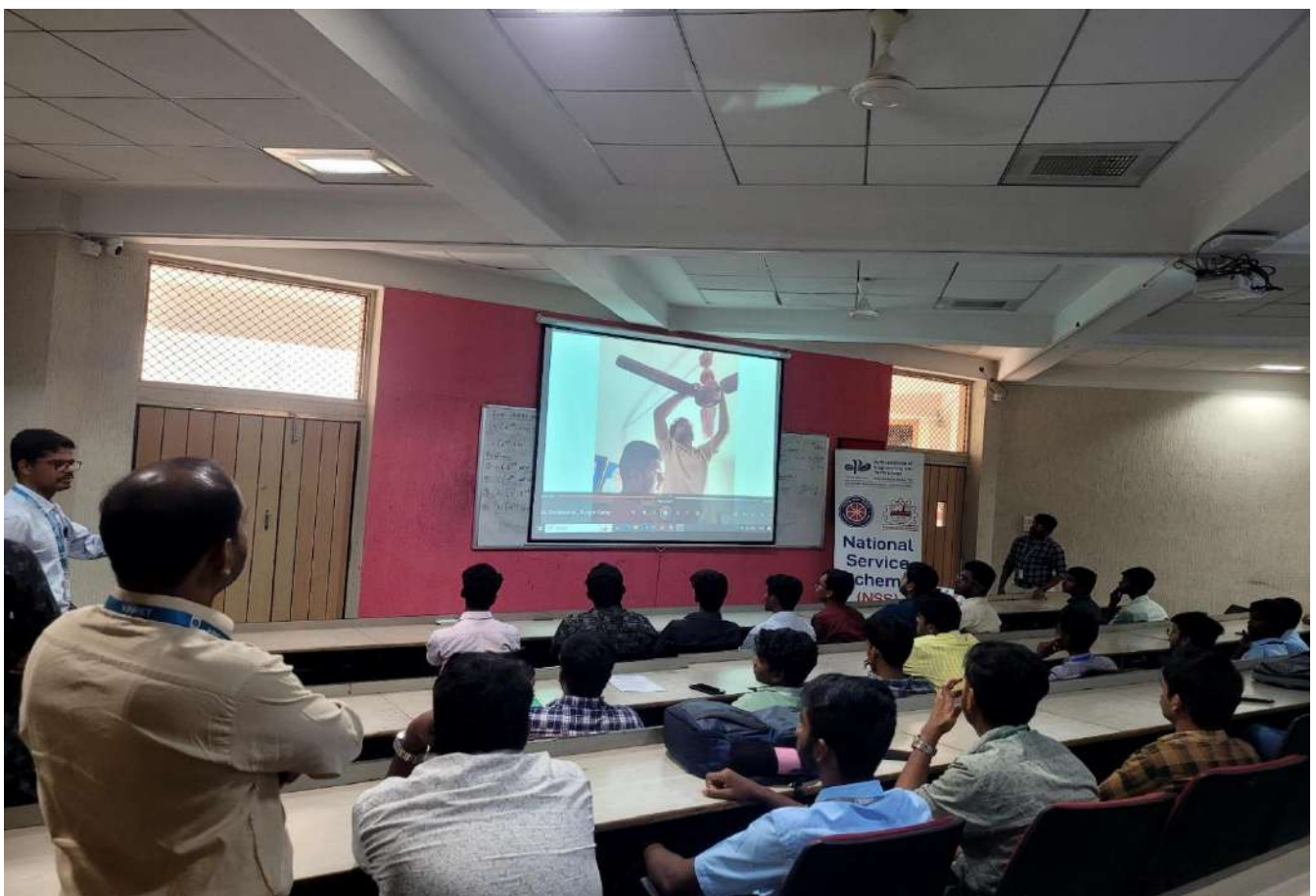




NSS Special Camp Orientation – 1

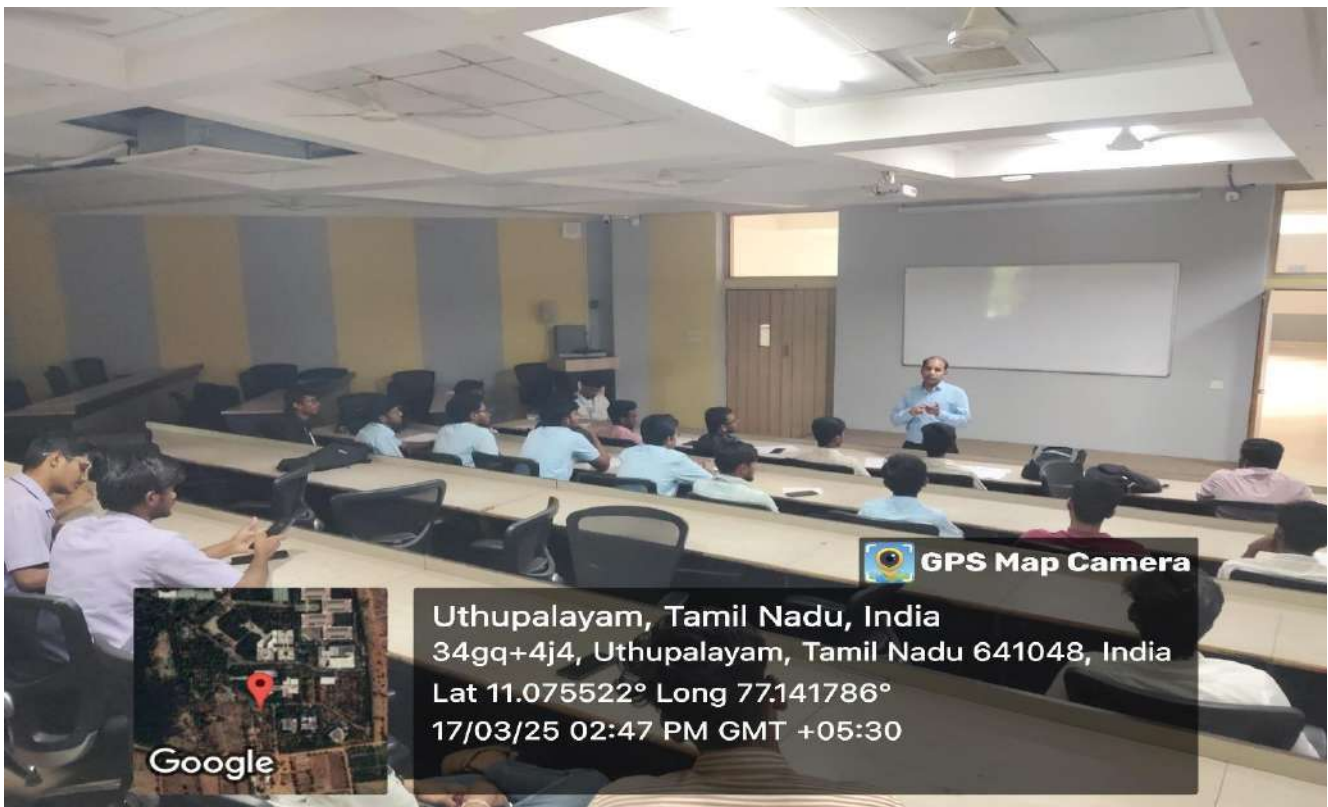

Civil works in maanar village school

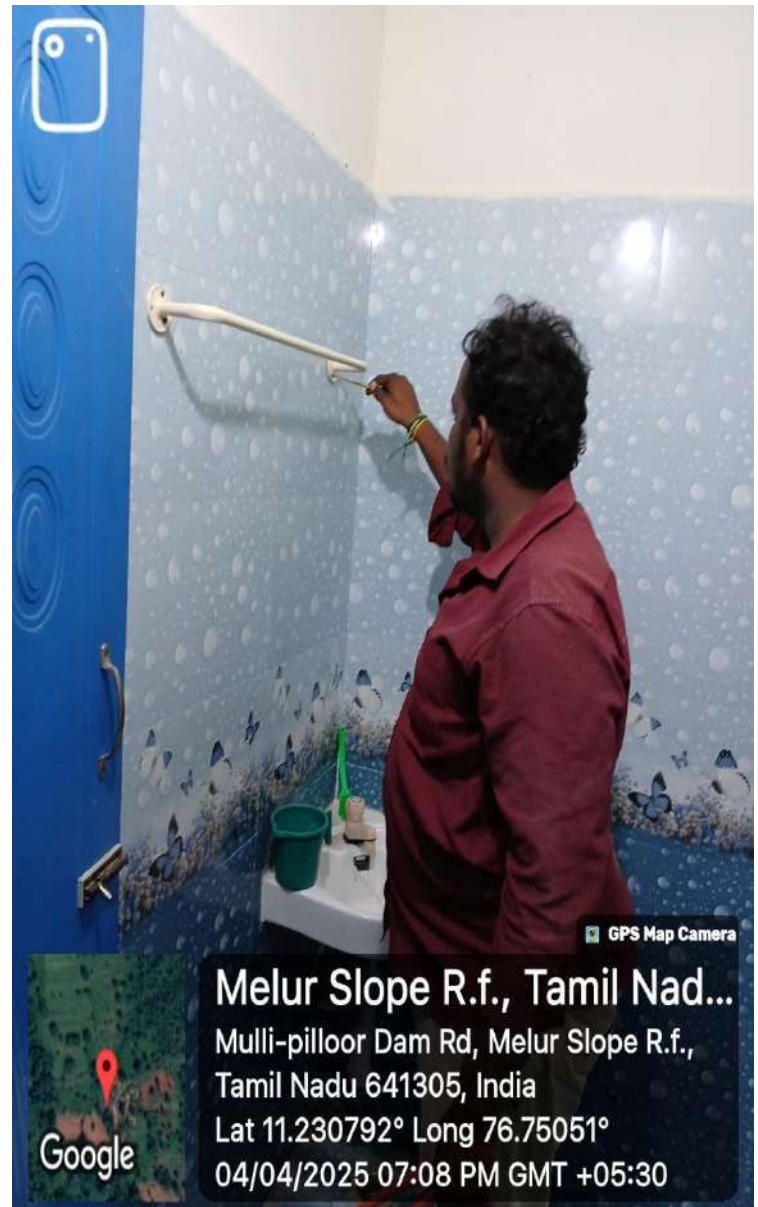

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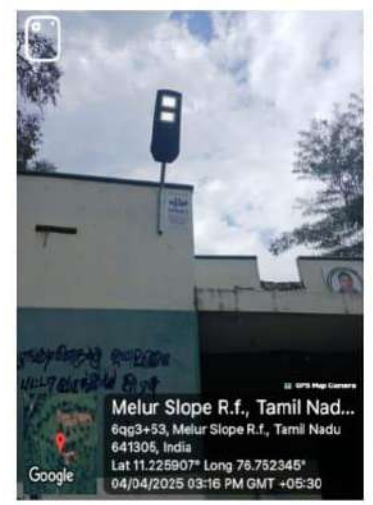


Solar light erection in the village

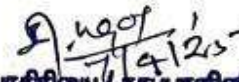
