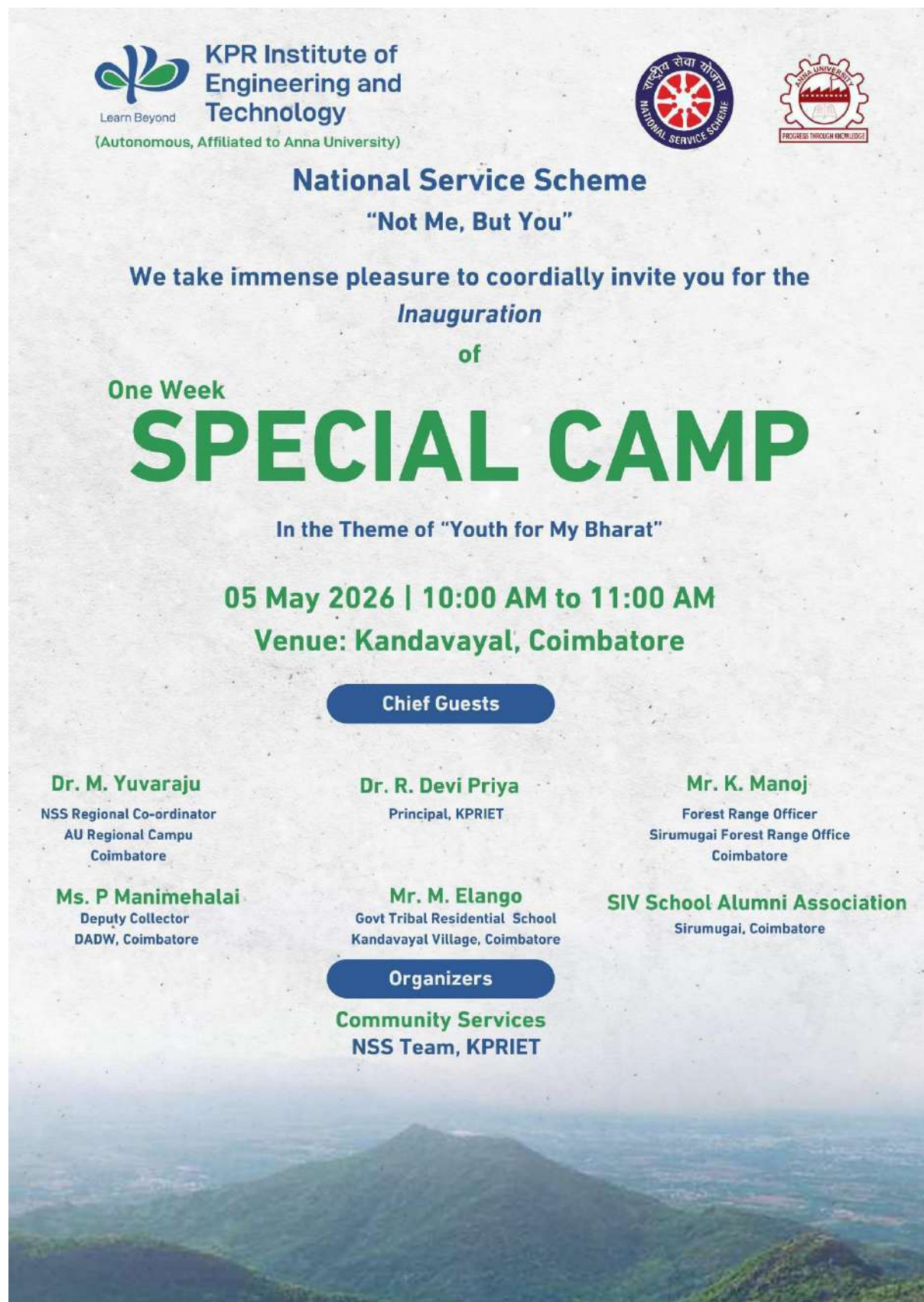

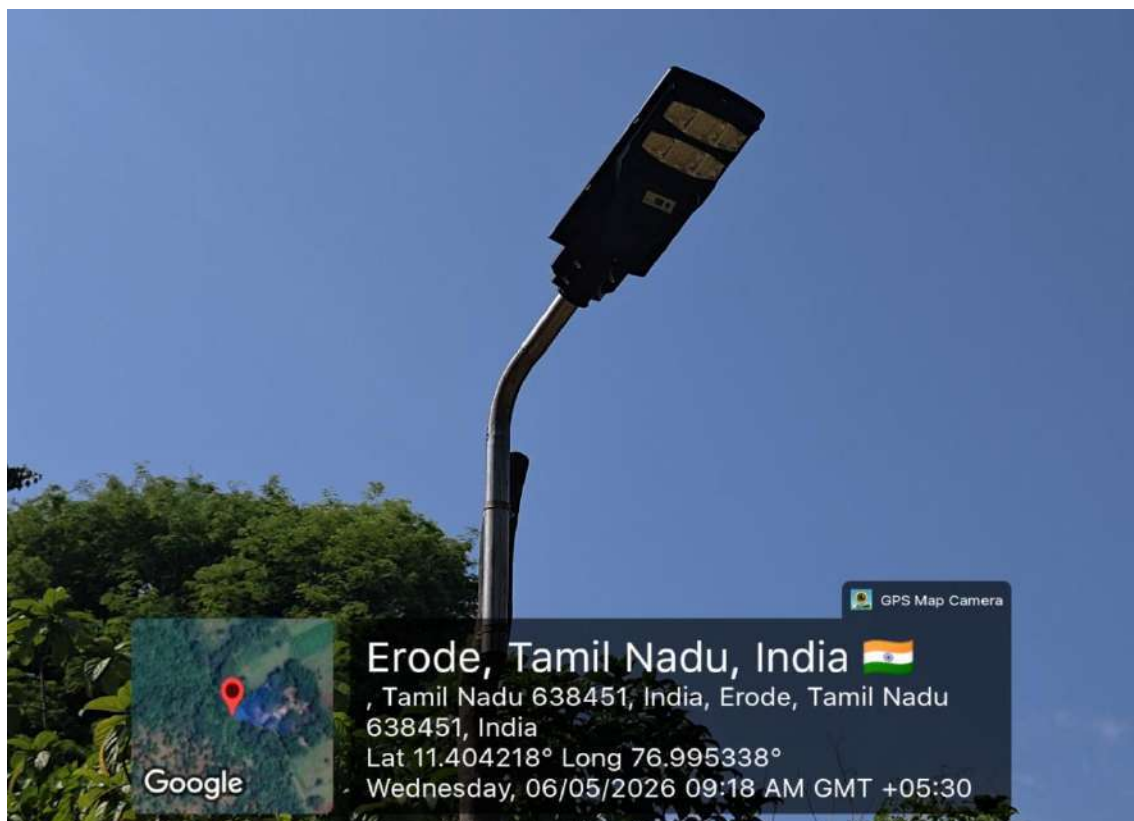

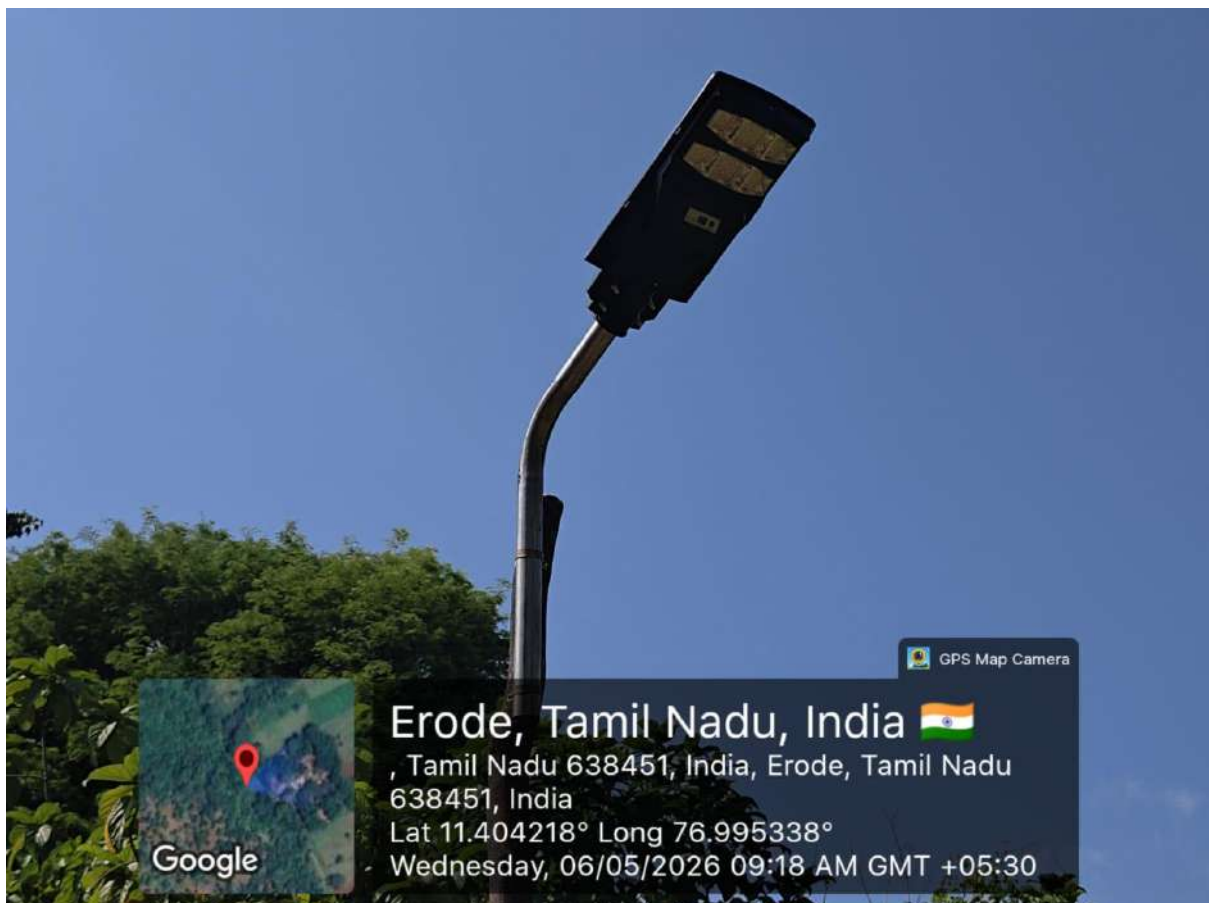


Solar Light erection in the Tribal Settlement

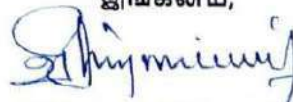

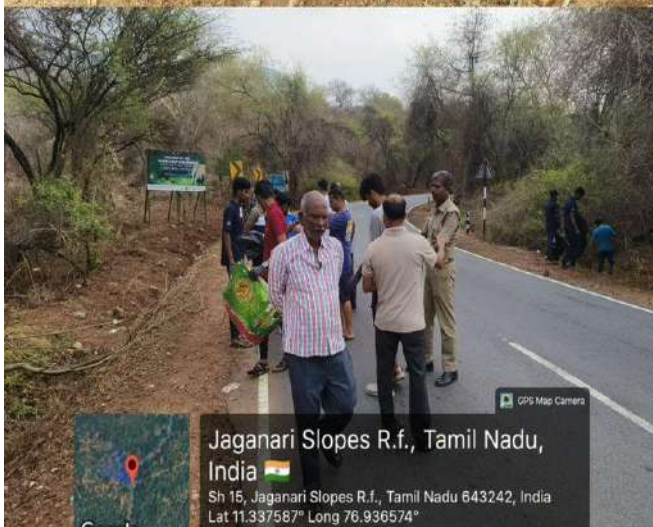
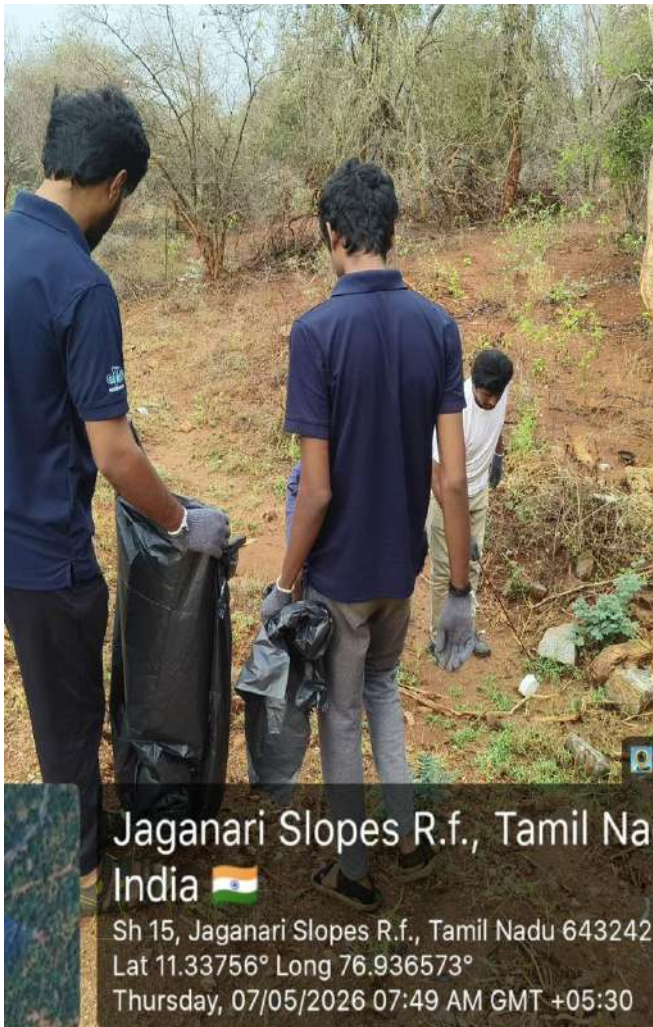
