**CIRCULAR**

As per the **G.O. (Ms) No. 164, dated: 27.08.2021**, all colleges in Tamilnadu are permitted to conduct physical classes on rotation basis with effect from 01.09.2021 by following the standard operating procedures. **Accordingly, our college reopens for the II, III & IV year B.E. / B.Tech. and II year M.E. students as per the schedule given below:**

In accordance with the guidelines issued by Higher Education Department, Tamilnadu and other regulatory bodies, our college has prepared the SOPs to be followed by all the students as mentioned below.

**Standard Operating Procedures issued by Higher Education Department, Tamilnadu**

The following public health measures are to be followed to reduce the risk of COVID-19 by all (faculty members, employees, students and parents) inside the premises at all times:

- ✓ No student will be permitted inside campus without vaccination certificate.
- ✓ Discrimination of fellow students in respect of whom there is a history of Covid 19 disease in the family be avoided.
- ✓ Students should follow the guidelines, advisories and instructions issued by the Government and the Institution regarding health and safety measures.
- ✓ Parents should not allow their children to go the college, if they are not feeling well.
- ✓ Parents should sensitize the children about healthy food habits and measures to increase immunity.
- ✓ Temperature will be checked daily for all students and staff at entry points.
- ✓ Physical distancing of at least 6 feet to be followed as far as possible.
- ✓ Use of face covers / masks is mandatory for all students.
- ✓ Each student should carry hand rub / sanitizers compulsorily for their use.
- ✓ Frequent hand washing should be done with soap kept at different locations (for at least 20 - 30 seconds) even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for at least 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.


- ✓ Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing /sneezing with a tissue/ handkerchief /flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
- ✓ Self-monitoring of health by all students & staff and reporting any illness immediately should be made to the respective HoDs.
- ✓ Spitting is strictly prohibited.
- ✓ Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App is advised wherever feasible.

Non Compliance of any of these guidelines will invite appropriate disciplinary action
