Tmt. A. Latha, Regional Joint Director (Employment), Coimbatore delivered the presidential address and highlighted the regular activities conducted by the District employment for

the beneficial of student community. The guest speaker also insisted the students to get job immediately after their degree and asked them to be focused and plan their career accordingly. In addition to that, she suggested the students to do self-analysis to find out their strengths and weakness. She kindled the students' curiosity by pointing out that more than 60 visually challenged people are working as PO in various government sectors. Mr. Vanangamudi said that there are plenty of opportunities in banking sectors and only the interest, positive attitude and daily practice are the real matters. He also suggested the students to open their own savings account in any bank and start saving in order to improve their problem solving skills and to know the importance of money. "Unless otherwise we are updating our knowledge no job will be a secured job"-Mr. Vanangamudi added. Tmt. A. Jothimani explained about opportunities in state and central government sectors including TNPSC, UPSC, IES, SSC, IBPS, RBI, RRB, and Armed courses etc. She also narrated the eligibilities, dates of examinations and applications procedures. Finally, the resource person discussed about the day wise regular activities of employment centre. The session ended with an interactive Q&A by the participants. About 700 faculty and student across the departments attended the session. Dr. P. Sreelatha, Dr. D. Aravindh and team organized this event.


