Event Summary

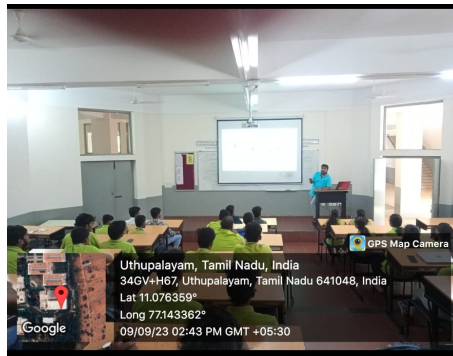
