Event Summary

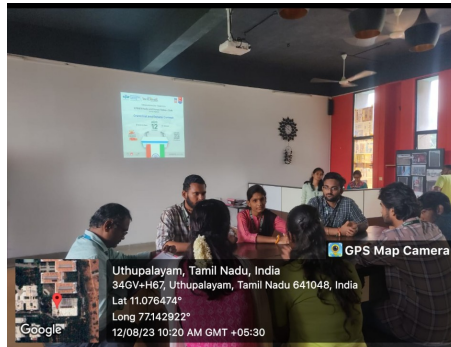
