Also in 2001, Temenos acquired a mainframe core banking application aimed at high-end retail banks, originally developed by IBM, and now marketed as Temenos Core banking. On 30 September 2003 Temenos launched its T24 banking package. T24 was based on GLOBUS, but with a state-of-the-art banking technology platform.
