Event Summary

District Level Awareness Camp on "Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme(PMEGP) was organized by The Centre for Innovation, Incubation and Entrepreneurship Development,KPRIET jointly organized by District Industries Centre(DIC),Tirupur, Khadi and Village Industries Commission(KVIC), Ministry of MSME, Government of India, Chennai and Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board(TNKVIB)Tirupur. **Shri. R. Siddharthan,** Asst. Director - II, KVIC, Coimbatore, **Shri. R. Rajesh,** Asst. Director - II, KVIC, **Smt.Brindha Devi**, General Manager, District Industries Centre, Tirupur was the chief guest for the Program. The Head of CIIED Dr. K. Ravikumar delivered the welcome address. The Chief guests addressed the following points during her session:

What is the Pmegp loan scheme?

The Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) is a **Government of India-backed credit-linked subsidy scheme**. Under this scheme, beneficiaries can get a subsidy amounting to 15-35% of the project cost from the government.

Who are eligible for Pmegp?

Any adult beneficiary above 18 years is eligible for financing under PMEGP.

Who is not eligible for Pmegp?

Assistance under the scheme is available only for new viable projects sanctioned specifically under the PMEGP. 5. Existing Units and the units that have already availed any Government Subsidy (under PMRY, REGP, PMEGP, CMEGP or any other scheme of Government of India or State Government) are not eligible.



What is the benefit of Pmegp loan?

With the help of PMEGP scheme, the Government offers subsidies up to 35% on the total project cost. The project cost covered is up to Rs. 20 lakh for service units and Rs.
