Phishing - Phishing attacks are the practice of sending fraudulent communications that appear to come from a reputable source.


Cyber Stalking - Cyberstalking refers to the use of the internet and other technologies to harass or stalk another person online, and is potentially a crime in the United States.

Discussion in cyber security issues with respect to identity theft and security the digital identity is happened with the students.


